


Our History

Ybor City Museum Society, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) non profit organization that owns and operates the Tampa Baseball Museum at the Al Lopez House, Rollin' Through History mobile museum, and the Ybor City Historical Society.

• The Tampa Baseball Museum at the Al Lopez House

The Tampa Baseball Museum is a brick and mortar museum housed in the childhood home of Tampa's first MLB player, Hall of Famer, and Manager, Al Lopez. The museum celebrates over 135 years of baseball history in Tampa.

• Rollin' Through History

Rollin' Through History is a mobile museum program created to promote Ybor City's history throughout Tampa Bay. The mobile museum is complimentary to the community.

• Ybor City Historical Society

Ybor City Historical Society is a haven of Ybor City history, and a cornerstone for researchers, historical enthusiasts, tourists, and natives. Working with community partners to preserve the cultural heritage of Ybor City.

AL LOPEZ

This inspirational Ybor City native was the first player from Tampa to make it to the Majors and the first to be named a Major League manager. He was the first player from Tampa – and only the second player of Hispanic origin – to be inducted into the Hall of Fame, making him both a local and national hero.
